About the Role

Under the direction of the Program Manager you will provide support for children and youth participating in clinical groups and day treatment programs on a call-in basis, and facilitation supports for psychoeducational groups offered at the Maltby Centre.

Responsibilities

- ◆ On a Call-in basis, provide skill based assessment, intervention, training, support and follow-up services with children youth and families participating in intensive child and family services, and Day Treatment Program.
- ◆ Provide skill based assessment, intervention and follow-up services. Services also include psychoeducational and treatment groups, and individualized treatment follow-up for group participants.
- ◆ The Intensive Services Counsellor functions independently in office, home, school and community settings to provide evidence-informed intensive intervention to children and youth with complex mental health issues and their families in collaboration with interprofessional team members. This position also provides support, education, training and coaching to children, youth and families.
- ◆ Services are provided to children, youth and families participating in intensive in-home services as well as providing coverage support for the Day Treatment Program, and SNAP.

Skills and Qualifications

- ◆ Child and Youth Diploma and/or Bachelor degree in Behavioural Sciences/Child, Youth and Family Studies with courses completed in child development, child behaviours, working with families and counselling skills
- ◆ Two years' experience working with children and youth with mental health problems that affect their functioning in areas such as home, school or the community
- ◆ An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- ◆ Current certification in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (FA/CPR), Non-violent Crisis Intervention (NVC), Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) and Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Systems (WHMIS), an asset
- ◆ Preference will be given to those candidates who are bilingual
- ◆ Valid Province of Ontario driver's license as well as automobile insurance with a minimum liability of one million dollars for *business purposes*
- ◆ Satisfactory Criminal Record Check (including Vulnerable Sector Screening) and Pre-Employment health assessment
