In addition, you may be required to participate in virtual After Hours On-Call coverage.

The ideal candidate is driven by a passion for the field of children's mental health services and has experience collaborating with community partners. You hold a current unrestricted registration with an applicable regulatory body, to perform the controlled act of psychotherapy. You possess a Bachelor of Social Work or other related undergraduate degree (e.g. Psychology). Your education is complemented with at least three (3) year's experience working with children and youth with mental health difficulties that affect their functioning at home, school or the community, formal training in family and individual counselling with children and youth and utilization of a variety of therapeutic approaches and clinical practices.

Training or certification in Virtual Psychotherapy, current certification in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (FA/CPR), Non-violent Crisis Intervention (NCVI), and Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) are assets.
