Formerly known as Pathways for Children & Youth, Maltby Centre is a registered charity and not-for-profit agency established in 1996 and funded in part by the Ontario government. Through the work of over 140 dedicated staff, Maltby Centre creates possibilities for change in young lives.

As a Senior Mental Health Therapist – French Language Services, you will provide assessment and case management services in French to children, youth and families from the francophone community to address mental health problems that are affecting their functioning at home, in school, and in the community. The position also provides supports and interventions utilizing evidence-informed therapeutic approaches and clinical practices to children and youth with complex mental health issues and their families in collaboration with inter-professional team members. In addition to providing support, education, training and coaching, you will have the opportunity to facilitate psychoeducational and treatment groups along with individualized treatment follow-up for group participants. This position is virtual for candidates who reside outside of a 150KM radius of Kingston. This position utilizes virtual service platforms to provide services and may be required to participate in After Hours On-Call coverage.

The successful candidate will work as part of Maltby Centre's Counselling and Therapy Team. As part of this team, you will help ensure that those who reach out to Maltby Centre receive high quality, accessible, evidence informed mental health services. Bachelor or Master's Degree in a regulated profession deemed able to perform the controlled act of psychotherapy (e.g. Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Psychology, Social Work) is preferred. Must hold a current unrestricted registration with a regulatory college to perform the controlled act of psychotherapy within the province of Ontario. Complemented with at least three (3) year's experience working with children and youth with mental health difficulties that affect their functioning at home, school or the community, formal training in psychotherapy, family, and individual counselling with children and youth and utilization of a variety of therapeutic approaches and clinical practices. Oral and written fluency in French and English required.

Training or certification in Virtual Psychotherapy, current certification in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (FA/CPR), Non-violent Crisis Intervention (NCVI), Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST), an asset.
