WHO IS IT FOR?

This free service is available to children and youth (0-24 years), caregivers and families from communities in KFL&A.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

In the first meeting child/youth and/or caregiver will meet with a registered therapist to explore any behavioural or mental health concerns. They discuss ways to use shared knowledge, strengths and skills to manage, as well work together to determine new ideas and next steps.

CONNECT NOW

Children, youth, or their caregivers are invited to make a referral to Maltby Center by clicking the QR code. Referrals are triaged and then followed up with by emailing an appointment date/time.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Children and youth aged 2-21 presenting with developmental disabilities, neurodiverse conditions (including but not limited to Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADHD, and sensory processing differences), or mental health challenges (i.e. anxiety and depression).

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Maltby Centre's Respite Services provide temporary, supportive care for children aged 2 to 21 with developmental, neurodiverse, and/or mental health needs. Designed to offer relief to families and caregivers, this program ensures that children are cared for in a safe, nurturing, and structured environment while promoting positive experiences.

- Operates 7 days a week between the hours of 7:00 am to 9:00 PM.
- Services are provided in centre (31 Hyperion Court), in-home, and/or in the community
